GUIDELINES TO MAKE A CROSS FOR A PRAYER PARK

We recommend that crosses are made out of **steel**, but wood can also work well. The following sizes are recommended:

- **Thickness of steel:** 100 mm x 50 mm square tubing.
- **Height:** 3,4 meters above the ground (vertical bar).
- **Width:** 1,5 meter (horizontal bar)
- **Height below the ground:** 600 mm
- **Depth of hole:** roughly 600 mm

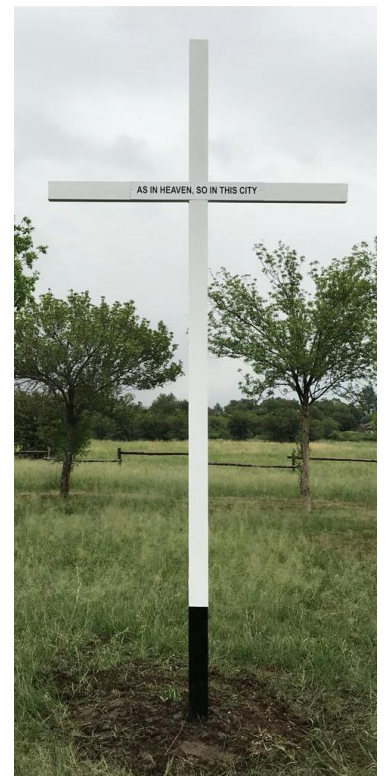
TIP:

To stabilize the cross, add a horizontal bar at the bottom below the ground.

Use **concrete** to plant the cross. Paint the cross white.

Signage:

- Print the proclamation **AS IN HEAVEN, SO IN THIS CITY** in black on a white background.
- Print it on metal board.
- Fasten it with silicon or metal glue to the cross.
- Height: 100 mm
- Length: 600 mm
